The Allemagne Deception

Donald J. Farinacci, Vietnam-era veteran, attorney and multiple award-winning author of *Truman and MacArthur, Adversaries for a Common Cause*, has earned unanimous critical praise for his change-of-pace, suspense novel, *The Allemagne Deception - A Novel of the Cold War*. 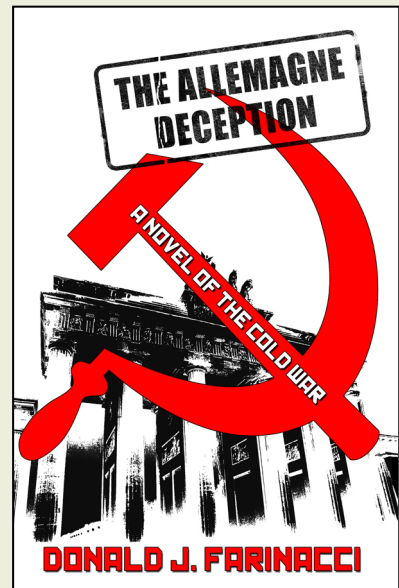
